**REGULATION**  
**OF THE TECHNICAL COMMISSION (TC)**



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### **1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

- 1.1.** The Technical Commission is the consultative body of the UFAK for the technical matters and is appointed by the Executive Board upon proposal from the President of UFAK.
- 1.2.** It will supervise the technical activities carried out under the aegis of the UFAK.
- 1.3.** The Technical Commission Bureau will be composed of the President and with not more than (03) other members of which one will be appointed Secretary of the Commission by the EB of UFAK.
- 1.4.** The Technical Commission will include/understand, in addition to the Office, of a “Bank of Skilled technicians” named by the Executive office of the UFAK and which will be particularly in charge of implementation of the training programs the technical.
- 1.5.** the Technical Commission Bureau is in charge of the management of all the technical sides concerning the activities of the UFAK; in particular training courses and competitions.
- 1.6.** The members of the Technical Commission Bureau cannot, during their mandate, being coaches, referees at the time of African Championships, or even President of Federation. Any member occupying one of these functions, or any other function considered to be incompatible with a perfect neutrality, will be removed from the Technical Commission.
- 1.7.** The Technical Commission will publish each year a list of the UFAK Qualified Coaches and the assessment of the technical training courses carried out. The list will be available at the latest at the end of December of each year. It can be consulted on the UFAK website.



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### **2. POWERS AND AUTHORITIES OF THE TECHNICAL COMMISSION OF THE UFAK**

- 2.1.** To inform the Executive Board of UFAK of any problem which may occur in the course of the UFAK Championships.
- 2.2.** To Ensure the application of all the rules and regulations relating to the Karate competition .
- 2.3.** To organize technical meetings during the African Karate Championships.
- 2.4.** To study and propose at the Executive Board the competitions' programming.
- 2.5.** The Technical Commission can make proposals in the direction of developing karate on a continental scale.
- 2.6.** The meetings and activities of the Technical Commission will be coordinated and memorized internally by the secretary of the technical commission. The official report will be sent to the members of the UFAK Executive Board and to the Technical Commission Members.
- 2.7.** To carry out the technical supervision of the African Karate Championships of and the official UFAK events.
- 2.8.** To organize, before each African Championship or UFAK official event, a meeting or a briefing with the trainers and coaches of the National Federations.
- 2.9.** To be responsible for conducting the coaches' examinations, in close cooperation with the Referees Commission, to draw up report of deliberation of the examinations and deliver certifications of licenses signed by the UFAK President.
- 2.10.** To supervise the behaviour of the trainers/coaches and officials during the African Karate Championships and the UFAK official events.
- 2.11.** To propose to the Executive Board possible measures for any coach who does not respect the Ethics Code of Conduct, the rules and the regulations, or who acts so as to harm the prestige of UFAK and Karate.
- 2.12.** In the event of serious infraction by a coach, the Technical Commission has the capacity to request the revocation of the coach or suspension of the coach's license.



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**3. POWERS AND AUTHORITIES OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE UFAK  
TECHNICAL COMMISSION.**

- 3.1.** To represent the UFAK Technical Commission.
- 3.2.** To convene and chair the meetings of the Technical Commission.
- 3.3.** To establish the agenda of the meetings, including the points suggested by other members of the Technical Commission.
- 3.4.** To take all measures and necessary arrangements for the smooth running of the meetings.
- 3.5.** To propose to the Executive Board of UFAK, all measures which, in the opinion of the Technical Commission, can lead to the improvement of Karate.
- 3.6.** To inform the Executive Board of all the resolutions adopted by the Technical Commission.
- 3.7.** To coordinate the location of the briefing and examinations of the coaches/ trainers before the African Championships or Continental events.
- 3.8.** To check the site proposed for holding the organizations and to deliver an opinion to the Executive Board.



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**4. FUNCTIONING OF THE UFAK TECHNICAL COMMISSION.**

**4.1.** The UFAK Technical Commission will meet in session during the African Championships or Continental events.

The meetings are convened by the Secretary of the UFAK Technical Commission, upon request of the Chairman, with the proposed agenda.

**4.2.** The quorum for meetings will be at least 2 (two) members, one of them being the Chairman.

**4.3.** The resolutions of the Technical Commission will be adopted by a simple majority.

**4.4.** The Members of the Technical Commission will cease their functions in the following cases: resignation, unavailability or renewal by the UFAK Executive Board of the composition of the Technical Commission.
